The first phase of implementation of the Samsung Group's new headquarters, this multifaceted project entails both renovation and new construction. It includes streetscapes and significant exterior spaces: the Rodin Gallery and events plazas as well as a pocket park. The site development, much of which is on roof-deck, is strategic in unifying the complex at street level, providing public amenity and signaling the high-tech profile of the corporation.
