### TOWERS|GOLDE WINS NATIONAL SCUP/AIA AWARD



Towers|Golde, Site Planners and Landscape Architects of New Haven, Connecticut and Yale University have won a 2008 Honor Award for Excellence in Landscape Architecture from the Society for College and University Planning and the American Institute of Architects for work on the renovations and expansions to the courtyards of nine of Yale's residential colleges. The Jury commended the stewardship of the campus landscape heritage in the nearly three dozen iconic internal courts which have all been completely rebuilt as part of sequential, major building and utilities renovation projects with highly compressed schedules over the past twelve years. The Jury also specifically cited Towers|Golde's successful preservation and enhancement of these seemingly timeless landscapes which have, in fact, been redesigned and reconstructed to accommodate 21st century mandates, including accessibility and sustainability, while maintaining the original design qualities that make each specific to the unique architectural heritage and to the culture and traditions of the individual Colleges: Berkeley, Branford, Calhoun, Davenport, Jonathan Edwards, Pierson, Saybrook, Silliman, and Trumbull.
